Volkswagen executives decided

Volkswagen knew how to write the  
software.

The company turned to one of its  
most trusted partners: the German sup-  
plier, Robert Bosch. Working from  
Volkswagen specifications, Bosch de-  
veloped code that instructed computers  
in diesel engines to fully deploy pollu-  
tion controls only when the cars were  
being tested in laboratories, according  
to lawsuits in the United States and Ger-  
many.

The code would form the basis for the  
so-called defeat devices, the illegal soft-  
ware installed on 500,000 Volkswagens,  
Audi and Porsche vehicles in the United  
States that has forced the carmaker to

plead guilty to fraud and pay more than  
\$20 billion in fines and settlements.  
The involvement of Bosch, one of the

hundreds of people for nearly a decade.  
Bosch, on Wednesday, agreed to pay  
consumers in the United States \$327.5
